DCWSA was also awarded a \$500,000 project grant from ADEM under the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program. CWSRF is a loan at 2.2% interest fixed for 20 years. The project will consist of sanitary sewer system improvements. The board is also in pursuit of an additional \$500,000 from Delta Regional Authority as additional funding for this project.



Dallas County has a major project underway for the renovation of the CR-41/US-80 intersection in association with ALDOT. The project calls for us to relocate our lines in that area, so that if there is ever a leak the pavement will not have to be dug up and replaced.



We are currently unable to complete Spire transactions with Western Union due to the fact of Spire changing everyone's account numbers.

Commissioner Connell Towns announced on November 9th, 2021, that DCWSA would receive \$150,000.00 towards projects from Dallas County Commission through the American Rescue Plan.
